9:00 a.m., Monday, February 13, 2012 - Post Election Audit.

Sealed absentee ballots for the Presidential Preference Primary Election, January 31, 2012, may be viewed one hour prior to each meeting. On Election Day, sealed absentee ballots may be viewed throughout the day.
